3) What did Abraham "find" in terms of "works"?
4) What is the context in which Genesis 15:6 appears?
5) What does it mean "it was reckoned to him as righteousness"? How did this "reckoning" come about?
6) How would you respond to claim that Abraham's faith was either a "work" or was "meritorious"?
7) What is the contrast that Paul presents in verses 4-5?
8) What is Paul's point in the contrast he presents in verses 4-5?
9) How does the fact that God is the One "who justifies the ungodly" support the argument that justification is "apart from works"?
10) How are we to "reconcile" Paul and James (Rom. 4:1-8 with James 2:21-24)?
11) In verses 6-8 Paul cites David's words from Psalm 32:1-2 to support a God-credited righteous apart from works. What is the particular "blessing" that is referenced here?
12) How does this Psalm support Paul's argument?

13) How is God able not to "account" sin to us?
